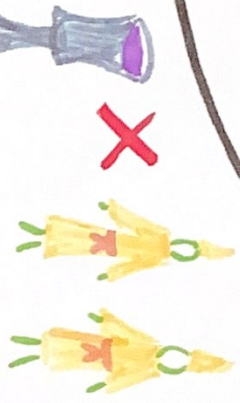

שמיני

ראשון

- It was on the 8th day of setting up the Mishkan which was 1st day.
- עולה, עולה to take a bull as an offering, ram as a sacrifice.
- Hashem told the goat to take – he-goat for a ram, calf and a sheep for an offering as a ram for a meal offering as a meal offering.
- They drew them near to the goat and Hashem appears to them.
- Hashem brought his glory then the rest of the rest of the day.

שני

- Hashem brought the glory of the day.
- Hashem finished bringing all the glory he raised his hands and blessed the people (ברכת כבוד).
- Hashem glory spread to the day.

שלישי

- A fire came down from heaven and all the faces and fell on their faces and a fire came down from heaven and consumed them - Hashem and Hashem were told to take the bodies of the dead out of the camp.

- The people were told not to tear their heads unshorn.
- Wine was given - not to drink wine before doing the work.

רביעי

- Hashem told the rest of the offering and eat it.
- Eat the parts of the offering that were brought in a state of mourning.

החמישי

- Hashem brought the meat about whether he should have eaten the meat from the day.
- 3 people were brought on that day, one of the ones of the day and of the day however not the one because he was an offering (Person in a state of mourning prior to a relative being buried).
- This was the first offering / understanding the offering, but they should be eaten like the other 2 offerings, but Hashem said that since he was an offering and unlike the other 2 was for the generations and going forward an offering would not eat from the offering.
- Hashem heard the offering and approved.

ששי

- A kosher animal has split hooves and chews the cud.
- The camel, hyrax and hare chew the cud but do not have a split hoof. The pig has split hoof but does not chew the cud. These are not kosher.
- Kosher fish have fins and scales.
- Torah lists 20 non-kosher birds the rest you can eat (we don't know what they are - so we have to have a list of what a kosher bird is, for it to be kosher).
- Insects are not kosher except certain types of grasshoppers which are kosher.
- Dead non-kosher animals are also a person that touches them must go to the offering and wash his clothes in the offering.

שבת

- If a dead insect goes inside an earthenware vessel, it becomes unclean and you need to break it.
- Food becomes unclean by touching something through one of the 7 liquids - water, dew, wine, oil, blood, milk and bee honey.
- Someone who touches a dead kosher animal, is also unclean and he has to go to the offering and is unclean until evening.
- There is another specific offering of eating insects.
- Be unclean because I Hashem am unclean, therefore don't eat insects.
