



NEW

- It was on the 8^{th} day of setting up the משכן which was 1^{st} ניסן.
- משה told אהרן to take a bull as an ינולה, ram as a חטאת.
- משה told the בניי to take he-goat for a השאת, calf and a sheep for an עולה, bull and ram for a שלמים, flour meal offering as a מנחה.
- They drew them near to the אהל מועד and Hashem appears to them.
- אהרן brought his קרבנות then the קרבנות of the rest of the בביי α .

שני

- אהרן אהרן brought the מנחה of the בניי last.
- אהרן finished bringing all the אהרן he raised his hands and blessed the people (ברכת כהנים).
- Hashem glory spread to the בנ"

שלישי

- A fire came down from ממבם to the מזבח and all the בניי sang and fell on their faces
- מזבה איש זרה brought an איש זרה onto the מזבה and a fire came down from heaven and consumed them אהרן was silent.
- מישאל were told to take the bodies of טוברהן out the camp.

שמיני

- The הבים were told not to tear קריאה or leave their heads unshorn.
- A מצוה was given not to drink wine before doing the יעבודה.

רביעי

- משה told אהרן, אלעזר ואיתמר to take the rest of the מנחה offering and eat it.
- Eat the parts of the קרבנות that were brought in a מקום קדוש.

ロない

- משה about משה between משה and אהרן about whether he should have eaten the meat from the חטאת of ה'ח.
- 3 אהרן אווח were brought on that day, מרלואים the ones of the מילואים and of the מילואים however not the ח'ר one because he was an אוו (Person in a state of mourning prior to a relative being buried).
- This was the first סברה וו מחלוקת טברה עומר understood understanding the משה. פסוקים understood they should be eaten like the other 2 חנואת בארן but אורן א said that since he was an אווא and unlike the other 2 was for the generations and going forward a אוון אוון שטעול שטעול חסנים.
- משה heard אהרן and approved.

- A kosher animal has split hooves and chews the cud.
- The camel, hyrax and hare chew the cud but do not have a split hoof. The pig has split hoof but does not chew the cud. These are not kosher.
- Kosher fish have fins and scales.
- Torah lists 20 non-kosher birds the rest you can eat (we don't know what they are so we have to have a ADDD of what a kosher bird is, for it to be kosher).
- Insects are not kosher except certain types of grasshoppers which are kosher.
- Dead non-kosher animals are also ממא a person that touches them must go to the מקוה and wash his clothes in the מקוה.

שביעי

- If a dead insect goes inside an earthenware vessel, it becomes NDD and you need to break it.
- Food becomes NOO by touching something NOO through one of the 7 liquids water, dew, wine, oil, blood, milk and bee honey. Someone who touches a dead kosher
- There is another specific איטוע of eating insects.
